The RSS will require you to make an election choice i.e., whether you wish to receive legacy scheme benefits or AFPS 15 benefits for your service in the remedy period (1 Apr 15 to 31 Mar 22). You will have 12 months to make your election from the issue date on the RSS

You will receive a Remediable Service Statement (RSS) from Veterans UK by 1 Apr 25. The RSS will be for information purposes only and will require no action from you. Approximately 9 months before your pension benefits are due to come into payment, you will be sent an 'election RSS' and be asked to make your election choice i.e., whether you wish to receive legacy scheme benefits or AFPS 15 benefits for your service in the remedy period (1 Apr 15 to 31 Mar 22)

You will receive a Remediable Service Statement (RSS) from Veterans UK before you leave the Armed Forces. The RSS will require you to make an election choice i.e., whether you wish to receive legacy scheme benefits or AFPS 15 benefits for your service in the remedy period (1 Apr 15 to 31 Mar 22).
