Veterans' Unclaimed Armed Forces Pensions

More than 17,000 unclaimed Armed Forces pension benefits*...



Historically, around 2,000 preserved Armed Forces pensions go unclaimed each year...



Anyone serving after April 1975 now aged 60 or over could have an Armed Forces pension if they served for 2 years or more...



The pension is NOT paid automatically - veterans must apply to Veterans UK using AFPS Form 8 or call 0800 085 3600 for further information
